ORDINANCE NO. 124-X-17-A



AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 11 "RETIREMENT AND PENSIONS;" BY AMENDING SECTION 11-66 "PROVISIONS FOR POLICE OFFICERS HIRED OR REHIRED ON OR AFTER SEPTEMBER 30, 2015;" PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CITY CODE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Sunrise entered into a collective bargaining agreement with the Broward County Police Benevolent Association for Police Lieutenants covering the period October 1, 2015 – September 30, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sunrise recently entered into a collective bargaining agreement with the City of Sunrise Fraternal Order of Police, Inc. for Police Officers and Sergeants covering the period of October 1, 2015 – September 30, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the collective bargaining agreements contain a change to the Police Officers' Retirement Plan; and

WHEREAS, to implement the retirement change in the collective bargaining agreements, an ordinance amending the Police Officers' Retirement Plan is necessary.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SUNRISE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The foregoing Whereas clauses are hereby ratified and incorporated as the legislative intent of this Ordinance.

Section 2. That Section 11-66(a)(4) of the Code of the City of Sunrise, Florida, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 11-66 - Provisions for police officers hired or rehired on or after September 30, 2015.

(a) Benefits. Members of the police officers' retirement plan hired or rehired on or after September 30, 2015 shall be entitled to the applicable benefits provided in sections 11-2 through 11-61, except as follows:

* * *

(4) Average final compensation for a police officer hired or rehired on or after September 30, 2015 shall be based upon the best five (5) ~~consecutive~~ years of the employee's last ten (10) years of creditable service.

* * *

Section 3. Conflict. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, all City Code sections or parts of City Code sections, and all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4. Severability. Should any provision of this Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part declared to be invalid.

Section 5. Inclusion in the City Code. It is the intention of the City Commission, and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of the City of Sunrise, Florida.




